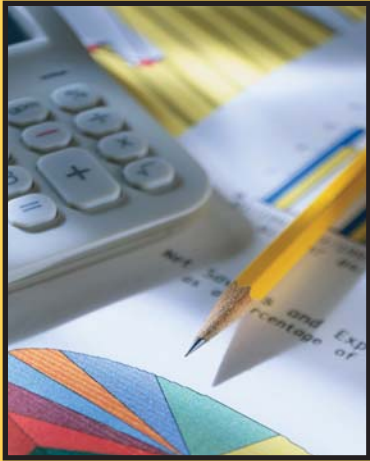


## B.E.T. ACADEMY

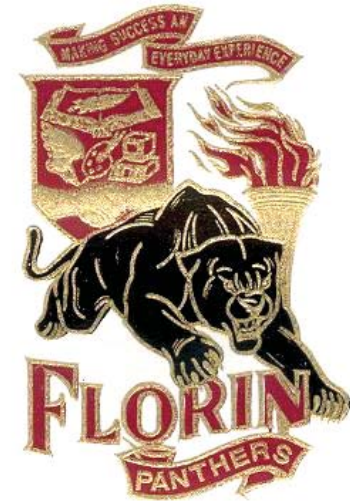
