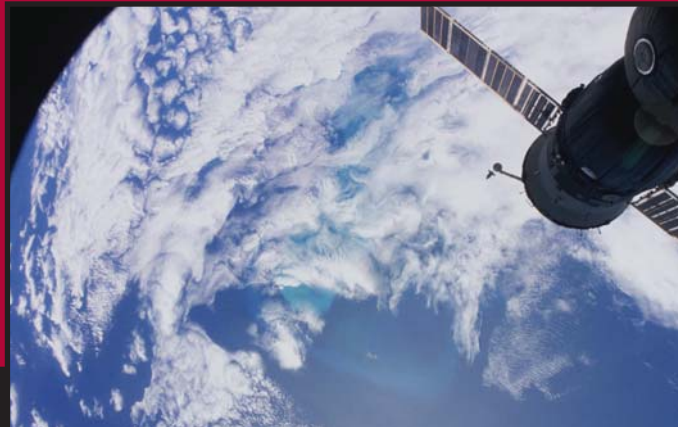
**Industry-based,
