#### 1. Involvement Process for LCAP and Annual Update

## How, when, and with whom did the school consult as part of the planning process for this LCAP/Annual Review and Analysis?

The School Site Council reviewed the LCAP Metrics on 1/25/23, and the current goals on 3/29/23. During the meeting on 3/29/23 the School Site Council reviewed the LCAP needs assessment results and made recommendations for the 2023-2024 site goals.

Administration, and the ELAC coordinator held an ELAC meeting on 11/2/22 and reviewed the current LCAP

goals and discussed the LCAP needs survey. On 2/1/23 a second ELAC meeting was discussed and the members present discussed and made recommendations for the 2023-2024 LCAP goals and action steps.

The site principal reviewed the LCAP metrics and current goals with the faculty on 1/3/23 and provided the opportunity for faculty feedback.

The site Leadership reviewed various aspects of the LCAP between November and April. Specifically:

November - reviewed LCAP Metrics

December - Site data

January - survey results

February - update on expenditures

April - root cause analysis of LCAP Data, reviewed current goals, made recommendations for the 23-24 LCAP

#### 2. Impact of LCAP and Annual Update

#### How did these consultations affect the LCAP for the upcoming year?

The information and feedback from all groups was considered in the final outcome and development for the 23-24 LCAP. Reflection of the following is addressed in each goal area:

Goal 1 - School site council and site leadership both indicated that additional support for students not meeting academic expectations is needed.

Goal 3 - All stakeholders expressed concern with campus safety regarding the bathrooms and that students understand the long term health impact of vaping.

Goal 4 - The ELAC felt that the school needed to bring back the Latino Family Literacy Project. Additionally, the site leadership committee felt that communication could be streamlined and more information be made easily accessible on the school web site.

#### **Resource Inequities**

Briefly identify and describe any resource inequities identified as a result of the required needs assessment, as applicable.

The following inequities were identified:

- African American students were suspended and nearly double the rate of all EGHS students and more than double that of their white peers. African American Students will benefit from additional targeted supports regarding identified behaviors.
- Students with Disabilities will benefit from additional targeted interventions and supports academically to make progress towards proficiency in both ELA and Math.
- Students with Disabilities were suspended nearly double the rate of all EGHS students, and will benefit from additional targeted supports regarding identified behaviors.
